## 'What if ...?' Scenarios: Thinking Outside the Box

'What if' scenarios suggest how different circumstances might impact the future. Your strategic planning team has developed a series of 'What if...?' scenarios based on the strategic issues your school faces now and in the near term. They are:

## Directions:

- 1. Choose a 'What if...?' scenario to process. Discuss the scenario based on the following questions:
  - What does this future look like in detail?
  - What are the positives and negatives of this future scenario? Is it mostly a positive or mostly a negative scenario?
  - What do you think about this scenario? How do you feel about it?
  - What would cause this scenario to happen?
- 2. Affecting outcomes of the scenario with strategic choices: brainstorm a list of possible outcomes indicated by the scenario.

- How might this scenario unfold if we do nothing?
- How might this scenario unfold if we emphasize...?
- How might this scenario unfold if we improve...?
- How might this scenario unfold if ...?
- 3. Arrive at consensus around what would be a satisfactory resolution five years from now of the question posed by your chosen "what if" scenario. This is your vision.
- 4. Develop a list of the four to six most significant outcomes you would see if you realized your vision as indicated by your chosen scenario and its resolution. These are your goals.
- 5. Work your vision and goals into a five-year plan using the template below.
